

## Accessibility Statement

**macle GmbH** is committed to making its website, [macle-shop.de](https://macle-shop.de), accessible in accordance with the national legislation implementing Directive (EU) 2016/2102 of the European Parliament and of the Council.

## Compliance Status

This website is **partially compliant** with the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.1 Level AA and the European standard EN 301 549.

The status of "partially compliant" is due to the non-compliances listed below, identified during a technical scan conducted on **November 26, 2025**.

## Non-accessible Content

The content listed below is non-accessible for the following reasons:

### 1. Perceivability (Graphics and Contrast)

- **Alternative Text:** A significant number of images (approximately 136 identified) lack alternative text attributes (alt). Consequently, screen reader users cannot perceive the content of these images.
- **Contrast:** Text has been identified placed in front of background images without sufficient contrast mechanisms, which is flagged as a "High Priority" issue. This severely affects readability for users with visual impairments.
- **Use of Color:** Elements were detected that use foreground colors without corresponding background definitions, potentially leading to readability issues.

### 2. Operability (Navigation and Keyboard Access)

- **Clickable Elements:** The scan detected 211 issues regarding clickable elements. This includes links and buttons that do not contain text descriptions or valid href targets (e.g., empty anchor tags), rendering them unusable for assistive technologies.
- **Focus Order:** There are issues regarding the focus order and visibility, making keyboard navigation inconsistent.
- **Semantics:** Content that appears to be a list is coded as paragraphs (<p>) rather than list elements (<ul>/<ol>), preventing screen readers from correctly interpreting the structure.

### 3. Forms

- **Labels and Instructions:** Approximately 104 form issues were detected. Many form elements lack the necessary labels or instructions, meaning users of assistive technology may not know what input is expected.

- **Error Prevention:** Mechanisms for error identification and prevention in forms (e.g., for legal or financial data) are insufficient or missing.

#### **4. Robustness (Technical Stability)**

- **Duplicate IDs:** Several elements on the same page share identical ID attributes (e.g., #product-action-quantity-group...). This is a "High Priority" syntax error that causes significant issues for assistive technologies when parsing the page content.

#### **Preparation of this Accessibility Statement**

This statement was prepared on **November 26, 2025**. The assessment was performed via an automated accessibility evaluation tool.
